Main clubhouse area closed for general access, available for Training team to use in inclement weather only, with social distancing of 1 m plus, subject to local Tier. Galley access restricted to 1 person Regular handwashing/sanitising for all individuals All payments to be made via card or prior to arrival via SCM All persons instructed to not come to club if they should be self-isolating in line with government advice No race paperwork to be shared/passed between sailors and/or race management team Access to office restricted to Chief Instructor/Lead Instructor/Committee Members on Club Business

Covid-19	Infection from Covid-19 through sharing of waterborne PPE	All staff and members	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Members required to use own Personal Buoyancy if owned Club owned buoyancy aids to be dipped in Milton and quarantined for 3 days post-use Club buoyancy aids to only be used for training activities 		
Covid-19	Infection from Covid-19 through shared boats	All staff and members	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Club Double-handed dinghy use restricted in line with current RYA and DCMS guidance All club craft to be sanitised post-use All persons requested to not come to club if they should be self-isolating in line with government advice Face coverings to be worn during powerboat and double handed training 		
Covid-19	Infection from Covid-19 during waterborne rescues	All staff and members	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All persons requested to not come to club if they should be self-isolating in line with government advice Safetyboats to attend all capsizes/incidents and stand-off Only a single household per safety boat unless social distancing guidance can be followed. Consideration given to methods of recovering individuals into dinghies to maintain distance e.g. mast lift/scoop method Race Officers and Duty Senior Instructors to dynamically assess conditions and take additional control measures to reduce risk of capsizes e.g. enforced reefing, increased ability required to go afloat. PPE available for all safety boat crew, with spares carried in First Aid Kit
