New Forest & District Sailability Health & Safety Policy Statement

The Trustees of NFDS recognise and accept their duty to comply with Health & Safety at Work etc Act 1974 and all related legislation applicable to our activities.

Our policy is:

- 1. To provide adequate control of the health and safety risks arising from our operation as Sailability Group.
- 2. To endeavour to maintain a safe and healthy operating environment although as an associate member of Spinnaker Sailing Club, who are the lease holders, NFDS has limited control of the site development.
- 3. To provide information, instruction, training and supervision as is necessary to ensure that volunteers are competent to carry out their duties and responsibilities.
- 4. To provide and maintain boats, hoists, pontoons, personal flotation devices (PFDs) and all essential equipment in good and safe working condition.
- 5. To take all reasonable measures to prevent accidents
- 6. To ensure that all volunteers are aware of safe handling techniques of both persons and equipment.
- 7. To listen to and consult with our members on matters affecting their health and safety and to act on their concerns and suggestions.
- 8. To ensure adequate and appropriate resources to implement this policy.
